The goal of the OASIS Provider Training programs is to increase the number of trained and qualified service providers who can then subsequently facilitate program development, implementation and coordination of interventions across multiple environments including home, community and school-based settings.



We provide several training options!

Each option incorporates an intensive training experience consisting of online training tutorials, interactive lectures, and hands-on training with a child (or a child and their family) with ASD and/or other developmental disabilities in a clinical setting.

ABA Provider Training

Behavior Specialist

2-day training covering Assessment, Behavior Intervention and Social Skills Programming

OASIS Parent Coach Training

Become certified as an OASIS Parent Coach and train families to implement ABA strategies with their child

ABA Provider Training

Direct Service Provider

3-day training covering basic ABA principles and implementation meets 40-hour RBT Training requirements

Gain general and working knowledge of evidence-based behavioral strategies to provide early intervention services to children with Autism Spectrum Disorders and other developmental disabilities and their families.
